



3N / 4D Aurangabad Tour

(ex Aurangabad)

From ancient times Aurangabad has been a place of great importance due to its location on the famous "Silk Route" that traversed across the breadth of Asia to reach Europe. The importance of Aurangabad is great, owing to its proximity with world heritage sites of Ajanta and Ellora. These sites have Buddhist, Jain and Hindu temples. The history of Aurangabad can be traced back to 1610, when the former Abyssinian slave and then prime minister of the Muslim kingdom of Ahmednagar, Malik Ambar establishment a city on the site of an old village called Khirki. His son Fateh Khan named the city he ruled over, Fatehpur in 1626.

The fortress of Daulatabad is 13 km from Aurangabad and is situated en route Ellora. Khuldabad, the last resting place of Aurangzeb, is 3 km from Ellora. Grishneshwar temple, an important Hindu pilgrim place, is located in the village of Verul, near Ellora caves. It is one of the twelve Jyotirlingas of India, where Lord Shiva is worshipped. Paithan, 56 km south of Aurangabad, is famous for its traditional Paithani silk saris. Twenty-four kilometers from Aurangabad lie the Bani Begum Gardens, which surround the tomb of one of Aurangzeb's queens. Pithalkora caves are 78 km from Aurangabad. Mhaismal, 25 km from Aurangabad, is another tourist spot.

Day 1 - Arrive Aurangabad

Arrive Aurangabad, you will be met upon arrival & transferred to your hotel. This afternoon you will visit Ellora, cave temples of three religions, Hindu, Buddhist and Jain stand next to one another. Of the 34 caves, the most remarkable is the magnificent Kailas Temple carved out of a mountainside, from a single rock, an engineering marvel! Rest of the evening is at leisure, overnight at the hotel

Day 2 - Aurangabad - Ajanta - Aurangabad

Today you will proceed for a full day excursion to Ajanta Caves, numbering 30, show embellishments including paintings and sculptures on the walls and ceilings. These portray the life and miracles of the Buddha, the lives of kings and the common people, of beautiful women, their Jewellery and hairstyles,

all marked by great dignity and grace. Overnight at the hotel

Day 3 - Aurangabad - Daulatabad - Paithan - Aurangabad

This morning you will visit Daulatabad fort, Rising dramatically over 600 ft above the Deccan plain is the arresting sight of Daulatabad. Once known as Devgiri, this fort served as the head quarters of the powerful Yadava rulers. In the 13th century, Mohammed bin Tughlak, the Sultan of Delhi, made it his capital and renamed it Daulatabad, or City of Fortune. This afternoon you will visit Paithan, 51 kms south of Aurangabad, the looms of Paithan still weave the beautiful Paithani saris that are prized by all Indian women.

Day 4 - Depart Aurangabad

You will be transferred to airport/railway station for your onward journey
